## SELKIRK GAME & FISH ASSOCIATION – RANGE RULES

***AT TIMES YOU MAY BE ASKED TO SHOW YOUR CURRENT MEMBERSHIP. ALL MEMBERS MUST SHOW PROOF OF MEMBERSHIP WHEN ASKED TO DO SO. YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SHOOT IF YOU CANNOT SHOW YOUR CURRENT MEMBERSHIP STATUS***

- 1) The range officer or range security officer is in complete control of the range at all times, their word is absolutely final
- 2) All firearms must be carried to and from the firing line cased or with muzzles pointed downward with actions open and of course, unloaded.
- 3) The actions of all firearms must be open at all times except when actually being used on the firing line.
- 4) Firearms are to be set down unloaded with actions open and muzzles pointed down range and not touched for any reason while people are down range.
- 5) Firearms must be pointing down range at all times when they are on the shooting tables, whether loaded or unloaded.
- 6) No firearms will be loaded until all persons are behind the firing line and the command that the range is 'live' is given.
- 7) All shooting will stop upon the command 'cease fire'. Guns will be laid down muzzles pointed down range, unloaded and actions locked open.
- 8) Firearms not being used shall be cased unloaded with breeches/actions locked open. Handguns will be secured in the same manner. No one shall touch another shooters firearms or equipment without the owner's permission.
- 9) A 'cease fire' will be called to check or reset targets every 20 minutes or on the mutual consent of all shooters.
- 10) During heavy use of the range, shooters will be asked to take turns on the shooting tables every 30 minutes.
- 11) Children brought to the shooting range must be under direct supervision of an adult in an area away from the firing line. Minimum age on the firing line is 12 years and must be under 'total supervision' of an adult.
- 12) Shooting on the range is for members only. Non-members such as guests or spectators that come with members are not allowed to shoot. Non-members using the shooting range may face charges of 'Trespassing' and 'Illegally Discharging A Firearm On Private Property'.
- 13) No glass, rocks, cement, computers or household appliances are to be used as targets. Tin cans or Plastic bottles shall be picked up and disposed of in the garbage bins provided. Remove paper targets from target holders when done shooting. Keep the range and shooting tables clean for other members.
- 14) Eye and ear protection shall be worn by shooters and observers in close proximity to the firing line all times.

### Additional Handgun Rules:

- Revolvers shall have their cylinder left open and empty.
- Single action revolvers shall have their cylinder empty and loading gate left open.
- Semi-auto pistols must have their slides locked open and magazines removed.
- Break open pistols must be left open with the chamber empty.
- Bolt action pistols must have the bolt left open and chamber empty.
- Holsters may be used to carry guns; however, positively **NO** loaded firearm may be carried in the holster away from the firing line. On the firing line, **only** shooters that are I.P.S.C./MDPL trained or those shooters who have taken an accredited holster training course may draw a loaded firearm from a holster.
